The Goodlettsville Branch Library is part of the Nashville Public Library system. More than a dozen shovels used in flood clean-up efforts in Goodlettsville were scrubbed spotless by city officials and then decorated by children participating in the summer camp program of the Goodlettsville Parks & Recreation Department. The current library on Old Brick Church Pike has served the Goodlettsville community since 1968. Civic

leaders, librarians, teachers, elected officials and library-lovers from Nashville and Goodlettsville will participate in the June 28 ceremony. The public is invited to attend.
